

LAMB MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Mr. Thuku's Estate

This Lamb Management Agreement ("Agreement") is made on this 14th day of
__February____, 2026, between:

Mrs. Samson (hereinafter referred to as "the Owner")

AND

Mr. Kevin Ngotho (hereinafter referred to as "the Manager").

1. Purpose of the Agreement

This Agreement sets out the terms and conditions under which the Manager shall provide care, nursing, and management services for lambs belonging to the Owner at Mr. Thuku's Estate.

2. Scope of Services

The Manager agrees to:

- a) Ensure that all lambs are properly and adequately fed with sufficient milk appropriate to their age and health condition.
- b) Provide and maintain cool, clean, and dry bedding for all lambs under care to ensure comfort, hygiene, and protection from disease.
- c) Monitor the health condition of each lamb regularly.
- d) Arrange and facilitate veterinary checks and necessary treatment to ensure healthy and sustainable growth of all lambs under management.
- e) Provide special nursing care for lambs that are sick or weak until they regain full health.

3. Veterinary Care

All lambs shall undergo periodic veterinary examinations to ensure proper growth, disease prevention, and overall sustainability of the livestock.

Any prescribed medication or treatment shall be administered promptly and responsibly.

4. Management Fee

- a) The management fee shall be three (3) buckets of chopped fodder per lamb.

- b) The fee shall apply:

Until the lamb reaches full health where the lamb was placed under care while sick; or

Until the lamb reaches full maturity where the lamb was placed under care for growth and management purposes.

- c) The fodder shall be delivered in good quality, fresh, and suitable for livestock feeding.

5. Responsibility for Loss

Responsibility for any lost, stolen, or missing lamb shall remain solely with the Owner.

The Manager shall not be held liable for such losses unless caused by proven negligence.

6. Duration

This Agreement shall commence on the date of signing and shall remain in force until terminated by either party upon written notice.

7. General Provisions

- a) Both parties agree to act in good faith and in the best interest of sustainable livestock management.
- b) Any disputes arising from this Agreement shall first be resolved amicably.
- c) This Agreement may only be amended in writing and signed by both parties.
